Notification of acceptance: **APRIL 15, 2013**
Submission of final papers and registration: **MAY 20, 2013**

The organizers will invite participating authors to be discussants of a paper.

FUNDING

Subject to the approval of subsidies by the Flemish Interuniversity Council (VLIR), limited funds will be available to cover for travel to Antwerp and local accommodation costs for presenters of selected papers that are nationals of countries on the Belgian Directorate-General for Development Cooperation and Humanitarian Aid (DGD) list (see <http://www.vliuos.be/index.php?navid=640&language=EN&throughadmin=1#anchor2130>). If you would like to apply for such financial assistance, please indicate this before MARCH 4, 2013 (along with submission of the paper).

There will also be a Best Paper Award for a paper of a young researcher (author and co-authors up to and including 35 years of age). The decision will be made by the Scientific Committee after the presentations.
